Session 1: Practical strategies for effective behaviour management

Thursday 22 November 1.30pm - 4.00pm £60 per NQT

This session will look at strategies and techniques for developing positive behaviour in the classroom, including establishing yourself with challenging students and effective solutions for difficult scenarios.

Session 2: Literacy, the teaching of academic vocabulary and understanding text types

Session 3: Subject Specific visit to an Outstanding school
